Carrez Connect Assembly Guide.



Overview:

The following information provides essential guidelines for the correct assembly of Archipello. Carrez Connect square and trough planters. Following this assembly guide will help ensure structural stability of your Carrez Connect planter.

Note:

The Carrez Connect comes as a self-assembly product. All parts needed to assemble the product are included. For the construction and shape stability of the planter, mounting U-profiles and tie rods are essential. Therefore, always install these if they are included.

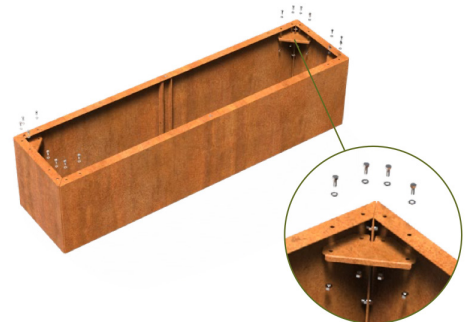
Planter Walls

- It is important that the product is positioned on a firm, levelled surface. If the ground is not level, the weight of the planter will be unevenly distributed. This can cause stress damage.
- Connect the 4 side panels while they are standing on their top edge on the ground. This means that the planter will only need to be turned once during construction.



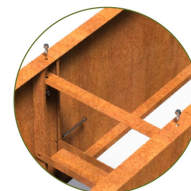
Corner Plates

- Use M8x20 bolts and tighten them until they are hand-tight. These can be tightened fully after fitting the corner plates.
- If corner plates are supplied, attach these to the corners. They should be fitted to the inside of the planter, with the raised edge towards the upper rim of the planter.
- Use M8x20 bolts and hand-tighten them first. Place the bolts with the bolt heads facing up so that the planter eventually stands on the bolt heads.
- When all the bolts are in place, they can be fully tightened.



Tie Rods

- Attach tie rods between the two long panels. If the planter you have ordered needs tie rods, these will be included. The tie rods provide essential structural stability to the planter and help it retain its shape.
- Loosen the M8x20 bolts at the bottom of the planter and insert the lower tie rod (the top rod in the diagram) into the U-profiles.
- Attach the second tie rod halfway up the planter using the M8x100 bolt.
- Once all panels and profiles are attached and the bolts are tightened, turn the planter over. Refer to the Archipello. Corten Steel Care Guide for essential guidelines to support the longevity, integrity, and performance of your Corten steel products.

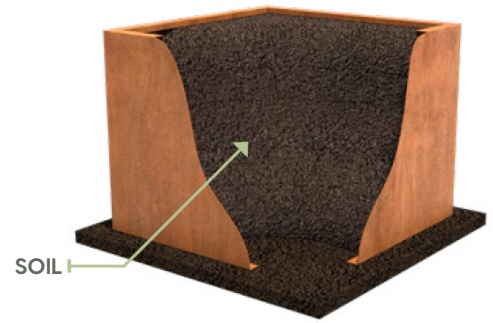


Planting Advice

Carrez Connect Without Base

- Fill the planter with soil suitable for your type of plants.

Note: The soil in the planter should never be tamped down, this can cause damage to the planter.
