



EcoWool Natural Mulch Matting

EcoWool is a fully biodegradable non-woven wool matting used in the establishment of trees, shrubs and ground covers in landscape plantings.

Biodegradable matting needs to be planted out promptly to work effectively.

Applications

- LANDSCAPING - Bank planting around base of trees, shrubs and ground covers, road edge, industrial and domestic sites.
- HORTICULTURE - Orchard tree/vine establishment and weed control mulch. Strawberry mulch.
- RE-VEGETATION - Re-establishment of NZ native plants.
- SOIL RETENTION - Mulch mat can also be used in the retention of loose earth embankments.

Features/Benefits

- Improves plant growth by trapping heat and moisture in the ground, increasing root development and extending the growing season.
- Discourages weed growth by helping eliminate sunlight and the ongoing need to apply herbicides.
- Biodegradable over 1-3 years dependent on gsm (may reduce in wet conditions), slowly releasing valuable nutrients into the soil (nitrogen, sulphur, sodium, potassium and magnesium).
- Very porous so will not impede air circulation or water and fertiliser penetration.
- Natural colouring (as opposed to some synthetic products) so will blend in well with any landscape project.

Fix using Ground Staples,
Greenstake Pins or BioPins

Available in rolls for large scale
planting (600gsm & 1000gsm).

Also available in diecut squares
(360, 450, 600, 900mm) for
individual trees.

Important: Before installing mulch matting or weed matting, thorough eradication of weeds from the area to be covered is strongly recommended. We advise spraying the site with an Organic Herbicide and allowing a few days before installing the matting.
