Planter Installation Guide.



Overview:

The following information provides essential guidelines for the correct installation of Archipello. Corten steel planters. Following these recommendations will help ensure proper drainage, structural stability, and a long lasting, even weathering process.

Note:

Corten steel products should be unpacked immediately upon receipt to release any moisture trapped inside the packaging. If the product is left in its packaging, it may develop uneven rust patches.

Installation


- Provide a flat, solid surface for the planter. Uneven surfaces can create tension which can result in damage to the product.
- If the planter is supplied with a tension rod, installation of the rod is essential to maintain dimensional stability of the planter.
- Install the planter providing sufficient breathing space (minimum 1 cm) around the sides to prevent moisture trapping.
- Never use an overflow pipe. No excess water should remain in the corten steel planter as this can cause the steel to corrode due to the interaction of oxygen and soil. Proper drainage is essential to the longevity of the planter.

Note: When choosing where to install your Corten steel planter, be aware that during the weathering process, rust run-off may occur.

Planting Advice

- Cover the bottom of the planter with a layer of gravel (approx. 10 cm, Ø35 mm grading).
- Place a layer of Advance Landscape Systems Filter Fabric Premium (SKU 260091) over the gravel for filtration and anti-root purposes.
- Cover the membrane with soil suitable for your chosen plants.
- Do not use hydro pellets as they retain moisture. Excess moisture in the planter can lead to corrosion.

Note: Depending on size and planter style, Archipello. planters can weigh up to 198.35 kg. Assistance may be required for moving or relocation. Refer to product page Specification section on the website for individual planter weights.
